Decorations shall not be allowed to be mounted on roofs or located outside the site walls or Building Envelope. Cut evergreen trees, decorated as Christmas trees, will not be allowed on the exterior of the Residence."

Community Updates

Evaluation of Roadways in Carefree Ranch

The CROA board is retaining an engineer to evaluate road conditions in Carefree Ranch. We've noticed several areas where the asphalt is lifting/eroding, and will be consulting with an engineer on repairs.

Motorized Vehicles on Private Property

Unauthorized operation of motor vehicles is prohibited on <u>all</u> private property inside Carefree Ranch. This includes in washes, ravines and hillsides/slopes found on both developed and undeveloped lots inside the community.

Mistletoe Threatens Trees in Community

The common areas are being maintained on a monthly basis, (trees and shrubs in the easements and islands are being trimmed), but we still have a <u>significant</u> problem with mistletoe throughout our community! Left untreated, it kills trees!

Mistletoe threatens the health and wellbeing of many desert plants, including Ironwood, Mesquite and Palo Verde trees. Side effects include reduced/stunted growth, loss of branches and very heavy infestations can kill the host plant/tree.
