Adopted during the November 15, 2018 Open Board Meeting

## The following plants/trees are **NOT APPROVED** to be planted within Cactus Park Estates:

Australian Bottle Tree-----brachychiton populeneus Australian Willow-----geijera parviflora Bamboo (all types except as follows)-----phyllostachys species Sacred or Heavenly Bamboo-----nandina domestica Beefwood-----casuarina species Blue Wattle----acacia saligna Brazilian Peppertree-----schinus terebinthifolius Cedar-----cedrus species Citrus trees-----Only allowed within the confines of enclosed rear or enclosed side yard. Cypress-----cupressus species Desert Broom------baccharis sarathroides Desert Museum Palo Verde-----cercidium x desert museum Eucalyptus-----All varieties False Cypress-----chamaecyparis species Indian Rosewood------dalbergia sissoo Juniper Trees-----juniperus species except those designated as shrub Mexican Palo Verde-----cercidium aculeate Mimosa-----albizia julibrissin Mulberry Tree-----morus alba Olive Tree-----olea europaea except fruitless species Silk Oak-----grevillea robusta Tamarisk or Salt Cedar-----tamarix aphylla and all species Willow Acacia-----acacia salicina eefwood-----casuarina species

Any Tree, Shrub, Grass or plant material that is invasive or harmful to climate or environment or people will not be approved and is considered on the Disapproved Plant List.
