## Rules for Gatherings at the Pool

If you will be having a gathering at the pool with more than 10 people in attendance, written notice must be given to the community manager.

Notice must be received no less than 4 days prior to the gathering.

There is a \$25.00 (non-refundable) usage fee and a \$75.00 (refundable) deposit.

Gathering must conclude by 10:00 PM

Use of the common facilities shall not be restricted or inconvenience other homeowners, or violate any of the existing rules and regulations in the CC&R's.

The hosting owner shall monitor the parking during the event to ensure that traffic can flow through the streets of the community. (Emergency vehicles are always a concern).

The hosting owner is also responsible for clean up and any safety issues that may arise during and due to the event. The hosting owner is also responsible for any and all damage that may occur during the event.

There will be a walk thru of the area by the community manager 48 hours prior and after the event. Any mess or damage will be noted and addressed at that time.

For safety reasons the maximum allowable at any gathering shall be forty (40) persons.
