- 3. You cannot use your garage as a storage area.
- 4. Street parking variances expire on December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, no matter the month you received your approval, it is your responsibility to submit for a new variance each year.
- 5. It is at the discretion of the Board as to how many vehicles each owner may have in the RV Storage.
